*Eighteen months ago New Waltham was in danger of losing the open space known as Greenlands playing fields due to austerity measures within North East Lincolnshire Council, this may have resulted in the building being closed down, the bowling green left un-cut, the football pitches overgrown and the BMX track uninsured so New Waltham Parish Council decided to take over the management of this area of our village and today operates it as tenants.*

*Since taking over the running of the pavilion, playing fields, Bowling Green and BMX track new life has been brought into the area and the Parish Council has received many positive comments from within our community. We now have a number of football teams playing there throughout the season, a bowling team playing there each week during the season, the Drop In for our Young People operates on a Thursday night throughout the year, we have a singing group meeting there on a Monday, we hold regular car boot sales and again this year we will be holding a picnic style event on 7<sup>th</sup> August. The Parish Council in conjunction with the office of the Police and Crime Commissioner has also installed CCTV to provide extra security and to try and deter any anti-social behaviour*
