Humberston & New Waltham Ward Update August 2017

Crime

There have been 32 reported crimes across the Humberston & New Waltham Ward for July. Of these, the following have occurred in New Waltham.

On 27th July a robbery occurred on Peaks Lane, when the victim was dealing with two punctures to his car. He was approached by two males, one with a machete, who made threats and demanded money. The victim handed over his wallet containing cash. Two males have been arrested for this incident.

Over 8th & 9th July, a shed at a property on Priors Close had the door locks forced. Although the shed was entered, nothing was stolen.

During the early hours of 23rd July, the flat above the Spar on Station Road was broken into. The intruders then dropped through the suspended ceiling into the store below. A safe was stolen.

Damage was caused to a car parked on Arran Close on 25th July by scratching the bonnet.

A car parked on Peaks Lane was damaged after stones were used to smash a nearside window on 30th July

Other crime include four thefts of cycles, (one each from Tollbar, Greenlands shops, the Pavilion, and a garden on Maple Grove), a shop theft from the Spar, two assaults, and two making off without payment for fuel from Tollbar Service Station.

There have been three reports of ASB. Issues with youths on the cycle track at the Pavilion, motorbikes riding on the fields in the area of the pavilion, and a neighbour dispute.
