Humberston & New Waltham Ward Update January 2017

Crime

There have been 38 reported crimes across the Humberston & New Waltham Ward during December, 13 of which have occurred in New Waltham.

During the morning of 4th December a vehicle parked on Hawthorne Avenue was pushed from its drive on to the road where it was searched. Property was stolen which was later recovered.

During the evening of 12th December a perimeter fence of a property on Station Road was damaged after a section of panelling was pulled down.

Two cycles have been stolen. A white and black Cube mtb was stolen from Tintagel Way around teatime on 15th December, and a white Cube mtb was stolen from outside the Spar the following day.

Other crime include an incident where an unknown male tried to take a mobile phone from another male whilst he walked along Station Road, two reports of making off without payment for fuel from Toll Bar Service Station, and five assaults.

There have been four reports of ASB. Two relate to motorbikes riding around causing annoyance, another relates to abusive teenagers at a bus stop on Station Road. The fourth was a neighbour dispute.
