Humberston & New Waltham Ward Update July 2017

Crime

There have been 33 reported crimes across the Humberston & New Waltham Ward for June, 11 of which have occurred in New Waltham.

Between 5th & 12th June, a home on The Orchard was entered. The garage key was stolen, which was then used to enter the garage and steal a lawnmower.

Overnight 9th & 10th June, a motorbike was stolen from a front garden of an address on Anningson Lane.

Overnight 15th & 16th June, a motorbike secured with a chain was stolen from a driveway on Peaks Lane. The chain was left behind.

Other crime include a report of theft over cash from a house by known persons over a period of time, a shop theft from the Spar, and a domestic assault.

There have been three reports of ASB. Two reports refer to YCA at St Clements Way, the other relates to reports of speeding cars and motorbikes on Station Road.
