Humberston & New Waltham Ward Update May 2017

Crime

There have been 38 reported crimes across the Humberston & New Waltham Ward during May, 17 of which have occurred in New Waltham

During the evening of 3rd May, a known prolific thief entered a store room at the rear of a fast food outlet at Peaks Lane and stole a quantity of meat.

Overnight 30th April & 1st May, a vehicle parked on Station Avenue was entered. Property was stolen.

About 4.30am on 26th May, a car parked insecure on its drive at Peterson Drive was entered. Property was stolen.

Batteries were stolen from plant machinery at a compound on Kirkness Close overnight 9th & 10th May.

On 2nd May, a car parked on its drive on Dursley Avenue had all four tyres slashed.

On 10th May a male was arrested after he caused damage to a car bonnet and fencing to enter the cycle compound at Toll Bar School, and stole a bike from the compound.

A male has been charged with assault and dangerous driving following a domestic related incident on land at the rear of Pennell's.

Other crime include three shop thefts, from The Star, Spar and Pennell's, and an assault.

There have been four reports of ASB. YCA outside the shops on Station Road. Youths on the roof of Enfield and New Waltham Primary School. Youths lighting fires at the BMX track.
