Humberston & New Waltham Ward Update April 2017

Crime

There have been 41 reported crimes across the Humberston & New Waltham Ward during April, thirteen of which have occurred in New Waltham.

During the evening of 6th April, there was an attempt to force a window of a property under renovation on Pretymen Crescent. No entry was made.

Hub caps were stolen from a car parked on St Clements Way during the evening of 6th April.

Overnight 15th & 16th April a car parked on Harvey Walk was entered. Clothing was stolen.

Over the same period, a car parked on Enfield Avenue was entered. A pushchair and handbag were stolen. The pushchair was recovered dumped in bushes nearby.

A van parked on Waddingham Place was entered overnight 28th & 29th April. A SatNav and other property was stolen.

And over the same night, a vehicle was broken into on Station Avenue. Tools were stolen.

Other crime include the theft of a bike from Toll Bar School, three assaults and inappropriate use of social media to send images of a sexual nature.

There have been three reports of ASB. A report of youths playing with fire on the pavilion carpark, youths throwing stones at windows on Greengables, and a neighbour dispute.
