Humberston & New Waltham Ward Update September 2017

Crime

There have been 38 reported crimes across the Humberston & New Waltham Ward for August (25th). There have been six reports in New Waltham.

A known male in company with two others were seen running from a property on Priors Close after being disturbed by the occupant who had heard the front door being opened. Nothing was stolen.

A known person has allegedly stolen cash from a home on Priors Close.

Damage was caused to paved steps in a garden at Garden Drive sometime between 12th & 14th August.

The remaining reports relate to allegations of assault, and a make off without payment for fuel from Toll Bar Service Station.

There have been three reports of ASB. A resident of Garden Drive reporting issues of YCA on the public footpath at the rear of the properties. Pretyman Crescent somebody shining a laser beam into the home, and a neighbour dispute.
